

Quick directions for graphing x-y scatter plots using Microsoft Excel.

Enter the data in the first two columns.

*Hint: Using a formula like: =A1+1 is an easy way to chose x values.*

*If you want to square the x values, you can use a formula like: =A1^2*

Highlight the data you want to graph, choose **Insert**-chart, xy scatter and follow the menu. Fill in the appropriate labels. You can copy and paste the graph into your PowerPoint.

When you have created the graph, choose **Chart**-add trendline-options to be able to choose the appropriate graph, and to display the equation on the graph.
